Funeral Services For Emanuel J. Hostetler was born August 30, 1975, in Etheridge, Tennessee, to Joe and Anna Hostetler. He was the oldest of seven siblings. While there, Emanuel joined the local fire department and rescue squad, and found so much enjoyment in it. He was actively involved there until his death. In the fall of 2020, the family moved to Monterey, Tennessee, to be more closely involved in their local fellowship. Emanuel traveled widely with his work and is lovingly remembered by many friends and his family as a man who would selflessly help others and put their needs above his own. Emanuel leaves behind his parents and siblings, his beloved wife of 26 years, and 10 children, Mahlon, Levi, Anna and Melvin Stoltzfus, Amanda and Daniel Troyer, Moses, Joe, Emanuel Jr., Anthony, James, and Lisa; and 2 grandsons, Jaxon
